Llais y Goedwig (LlyG) is developing a series of publications which we hope will be of use to individuals, groups and organisations involved in or interested in community woodlands in Wales.

Advisory Notes

The purpose of the Advisory Notes is to help community woodland groups across Wales develop best practice and share knowledge and skills. To be successful, community woodland management has to meet the needs of both local people and develop the woodland in ways which achieve the greatest benefits. Achieving this can seem daunting, especially if it is the first time a community has been involved with woodlands or if it involves balancing the demands of many different groups (how do you provide for mountain bikers, walkers, firewood collectors and those who just want the woodland to 'stay the same'?) The Advisory Notes are a series of short publications which offer advice, clarify theory and illuminate the practice of managing a woodland as a group. The first of these are based on presentations given by LlyG members during our summer 2010 Woodland Management Roadshows

Mae Llais y Goedwig (LlyG) yn datblygu cyfres o gyhoeddiadau y gobeithiwn fydd o ddefnydd i unigolion, grwpiau a sefydliadau sydd yn ymwneud â neu gyda diddordeb mewn coedlannau cymunedol yng Nghymru. Mae dwy set o gyhoeddiadau yn cael eu datblygu: **Nodiadau Ymgynghorol ac Astudiaethau Achos.**

Nodiadau Ymgynghorol

Pwrpas y Nodiadau Ymgynghorol yw cynorthwyo grwpiau coetir cymunedol ar draws Cymru i ddatblygu arferion gorau a rhannu gwybodaeth a sgiliau. I fod yn llwyddiannus, rhaid i reolaeth coedlan gymunedol ddiwallu anghenion y bobl leol a hefyd datblygu'r goedlan yn y modd mwyaf manteisiol. Gall cyflawni hyn ymddangos yn frawychus, yn enwedig os mai dyma'r tro cyntaf i'r gymuned fod yn ymwneud â choedlannau, neu os yw'n golygu cydbwysu gofynion llawer o wahanol grwpiau (sut mae modd darparu ar gyfer beicwyr mynydd, cerddwyr, casglwyr coed tân a'r rheini sydd am i'r goedlan 'aros fel y mae'?) Mae'r Nodiadau Ymgynghorol yn gyfres o gyhoeddiadau byr sy'n cynnig cyngor, yn egluro damcaniaeth a thaflu goleuni ar yr arfer o reoli coedlan fel grŵp. Mae'r cyntaf o'r rhain yn seiliedig ar gyflwyniadau a roddwyd gan aelodau LlyG yn ystod ein Sioeau Teithiol Rheoli Coedlannau Haf 2010.

Y ffynonellau mwyaf defnyddiol o'r cyngor ar gael yw'r rhai sy'n tynnu ar brofiad gwirioneddol o reoli coedlan dan arweiniad cymuned yng Nghymru. Astudiaethau achos

Mae'r pwyslais ar werthusiad gonest o'r hyn weithiodd neu na weithiodd fel ffynhonnell cyngor ystyrlon i grwpiau eraill. Cafodd y pum astudiaeth achos cyntaf eu comisiynu fel rhan o brosiect cefnogi cyntaf y Comisiwn Coedwigaeth efo Llais y Goedwig, ond gobeithiwn ychwanegu mwy o straeon i'r gyfres yma. Mae taith pob grŵp yn un wahanol a byddai'n wych pe gallech rannu eich profiad o'r hyn sydd wedi a'r hyn sydd heb weithio i chi. Efallai eich bod wedi dod o hyd i ffordd arloesol o gynnwys pobl mewn arolwg bywyd gwylt coedlan neu eich bod wedi mynd i'r afael â fandaliaeth coedlan yn llwyddiannus, neu bod gennych gynllun coedlan gymunedol yr hoffech ei rannu.
